

## Round Cotton Washcloth

### Materials Needed:

Worsted weight cotton yarn (Like Sugar N' Cream or Peaches N' Cream)  
Size 7 Straight Needles  
Large eye needle



### Directions:

Cast on 15 sts.

Rows 1, 3, 5 and 7: k15

Row 2: k3, yo, k11; turn and leave 1 st on needle

Row 4: k3, yo, k11; turn and leave 2 sts on needle

Row 6: k3, yo, k11; turn and leave 3 sts on needle

Row 8: bind off 3 sts; k2, yo, k8; turn leave 4 sts on needle

Rows 9, 11, and 13: k12

Row 10: k3, yo, k8; turn leave 5 sts on needle

Row 12: k3, yo, k8; turn leave 6 sts on needle

Row 14: Bind off 3 sts; k2, yo, k5; turn leave 7 sts on needle

Rows 15, 17, and 19: k9

Row 16: k3, yo, k5; turn leave 8 sts on needle

Row 18: k3, yo, k5; turn leave 9 sts on needle

Row 20: Bind off 3 sts; knit remaining 14 stitches (15 on needle)

Repeat rows 1-20 7 times more

Bind off leaving an 18 inch tail

### Finishing:

Sew cast on edge to bind off edge forming circle

### NOTES:

You can play with this pattern to give some variety. Instead of a YO you can do any type of increase like Make 1 or knit 1 front and back. Instead of knitting the odd rows, you can purl them. Once you have gotten the hang of this pattern, you can get creative and make it your own.
